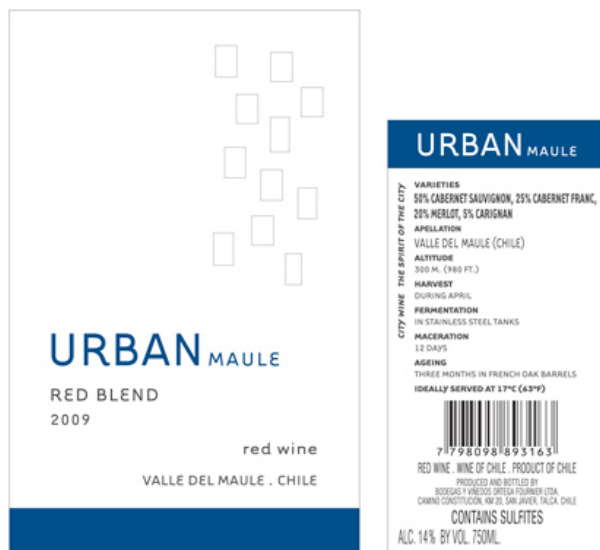

<b>Name of the wine</b>	Urban Red Blend
<b>Vintage</b>	2009
<b>Varieties</b>	50% Cabernet Sauvignon, 25% Cabernet Franc, 20% Merlot, 5% Carignan

<b>Technical analysis</b>	
Alcohol	14.0%
Total acidity (as tartaric)	5.4 g/L
pH	3.51
Residual sugar	2.95 g/l

<b>Vineyard description</b>	
Appellation	Maule Valley – Chile
Soil	Alluvional, free draining, sandy loams.
Altitude	Around 90 m
Management	Generally old vines (between 40 to 100 years), cane pruned and VSP trellised. Limited flood irrigation. Yields are around 50 hL/ha.

<b>Winemaking characteristics</b>	
Harvest	By hand, during April. Grapes sorted at the winery
Maceration	In stainless steel tanks, at 28°C
Fermentation	At 24°C, between 8 and 24 days

Barrel ageing	3 months in used French oak barrels.
Filtration	Unfined, filtered
